### **General Nominating Committee Information\*** **Supplier Council By-Laws\***

*“Any School Transportation Supplier Council company may request consideration for a seat on the Steering Committee by presenting a business card and relevant company information on company letterhead to any current member of the Nominating Committee or the Steering Committee at least 10 days prior to Supplier Council meeting held in conjunction with the Annual NASDPTS Conference. The Nominating Committee shall recommend new members to the full Steering Committee. The request will be considered and voted upon at the annual meeting of the School Transportation Supplier Council held on the last day of the NASDPTS Annual Conference. Nominees will be admitted to the Committee upon the approval of a two-thirds vote of all members of the Steering Committee.*”

*“To be eligible for a seat on the Steering Committee, individuals must be designated in writing to NASDPTS as the representative of the School Transportation Supplier Council by the company's Vice President or equivalent executive management member. The individual so designated is expected to actively participate in the affairs of the Committee; substitutions for convenience sake are unacceptable. Nominees for a seat on the Steering Committee must be executive management level officials in a policy making position in their organization, or be given authority by top management to act on behalf of their company.”*

- 1) Any Supplier Council company may request consideration for a seat by relevant company information on company letterhead by October 1, 2011. This is 20 days prior to the annual NASDPTS conference. This can be mailed to David Harden [718 Camarague Place #206 Lake Mary, FL 32746] or contact any member of the Nominating Committee via email.

- 2) Nominating Committee shall recommend new members to the full Steering Committee. The request will be considered and voted on at the annual meeting held in conjunction with the NASDPTS annual Supplier Council meeting on the last day of the NASDPTS Annual Conference.
- 3) Nominees will be admitted upon approval of two-thirds vote of all members.

#### Requirements & Guidelines for Steering Committee Members

##### 1) Requirements

- i. Position held by Individuals of Supplier Member Companies
- ii. Dues paying members of NASDPTS (in good standing)
- iii. Total of 11 members
- iv. Designated in writing to NASDPTS as the representative of the School Transportation Supplier Council by Company's top management
- v. Consist of two bus body manufacturers (type C or D) and one company that manufacturers only type A or B
- vi. Individual is expected to actively participate in the affairs of the committee
- vii. Must be executive management level officials in policy making position in their organization
- viii. No more than three representatives from competitive businesses allowed at one time
- ix. Willing to work without compensation
- x. Election of officers shall take place after new members are seated on the Steering Committee.
- xi. Terms of office shall be for 3 years
- xii. Officers are eligible for reelection
- xiii. Members can serve up to two consecutive terms on the Steering Committee; members companies are eligible for reelection after a one-year absence from the committee.

##### 2) Guidelines.

- i. Active participation in Supplier Council for a period of at least two years
- ii. Attendance at all meetings
